BILL TOPIC: INFORM STUDENTS & PARENTS OF EDUCATION LEADING TO JOBS

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, all public schools are required to assist parents and students to create an Individual Career and Academic Plan (ICAP). This bill requires that schools also discuss the various career pathways available to postsecondary students, and the types of certificates and jobs to which each pathway leads. The schools are also encouraged to discuss the skills and educational opportunities available through military enlistment. When discussing military enlistment with a student and his or her parent, the bill encourages but does not require that public schools provide certain information concerning the military enlistment test, including suggestions on how to prepare for the test.

School District Impact

The bill minimally increases the workload of school districts and institute charter schools to provide information to students concerning existing career pathways and the benefits of military enlistment.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 20, 2017, and takes effect August 9, 2017, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
