Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$42,056 cash funds from the Division of Professions and Occupations Cash Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2019-20. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.6 FTE.
