# **Summary of Legislation**

The bill requires that the Office of the State Controller transfer the balance of any repealed cash fund to the General Fund. The office must annually submit a report to the Joint Budget Committee that identifies any funds that have not been appropriated in the prior two state fiscal years, the balance of those funds, and the total amount that the office has transferred to the General Fund from repealed cash funds.

### **State Transfers**

Unless otherwise provided, the bill transfers the balance of any repealed cash fund to the General Fund on June 30, 2025 (in the current FY 2024-25), and each June 30 thereafter. No estimate of the amount to be transferred is available.

# **State Expenditures**

The bill increases workload for the State Controller in the Department of Personnel and Administration to prepare annual reports for the Joint Budget Committee. This effort does not require new appropriations.

#### **Effective Date**

This bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on June 3, 2025.
