#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$4,570,741 cash funds from the Broadband Infrastructure Cash Fund to the Department of Corrections for FY 2024-25. Of this amount, \$88,080 is based on an assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.9 FTE.

## **Points to Consider**

### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2024-25 budget package the \$4,570,741 General Fund revenue decrease that would result from the passage of this bill.
