**Fiscal Note Status**

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The most recent Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note (attached) reflects the fiscal impact of the bill as of 04/04/2025.

**Update:** Fiscal impact has changed due to new information or technical issues.

Technical note: The fiscal note includes \$17,125 for the purchase of document management services by the Department of State. These services are provided by the Department of Personnel, which requires an equal amount of spending authority.

The State, Civic, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee Report (04/07/25) includes amendments to the bill. JBC Staff and LCS Fiscal Note Staff agree that these amendments will not change the fiscal impact of the bill.
