102	INDEFINITELY, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN
103	APPROPRIATION.

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-4-2208, <u>amend</u>
(4) as follows:
25-4-2208. Necessary document program - <u>report -</u> definition.
(4) This section is repealed, effective September 1, 2021. <u>BEGINNING</u>
JANUARY 1, 2032, AND EACH FIVE YEARS THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT
SHALL INCLUDE, AS PART OF ITS ANNUAL PRESENTATION TO THE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY PURSUANT TO THE "STATE MEASUREMENT FOR ACCOUNTABLE,
RESPONSIVE, AND TRANSPARENT (SMART) GOVERNMENT ACT", PART 2
OF ARTICLE 7 OF TITLE 2, A REPORT ON THE TOTAL NUMBER OF NECESSARY
DOCUMENTS ACQUIRED ON AN ANNUAL BASIS AND ANY SIGNIFICANT
TECHNOLOGICAL CHANGES OR OTHER DEVELOPMENTS THAT AFFECT THE
NEED FOR, OR OPERATIONS OF, THE NECESSARY DOCUMENT PROGRAM.
SECTION 2. Appropriation. For the 2021-22 state fiscal year,
\$250,000 is appropriated to the department of public health and
environment for use by the office of health equity. This appropriation is
from the general fund. To implement this act, the office may use this
appropriation for necessary document assistance.
SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
