Summary of Legislation

This bill changes the name of the Division of Labor and Employment within the Colorado Department of Labor and Employment (CDLE) to the Division of Labor Standards and Statistics.

State Expenditures

For FY 2016-17 only, the bill increases workload for the CDLE by a minimal amount to update forms, business cards, its website, and other similar materials to reflect the change in the name of the division. No adjustments in appropriations for CDLE are required.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 22, 2016, and takes August 10, 2016, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
