After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB25-1215 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

29 42-4-1208. Unexpended and unencumbered money in the fund at the end
30 of a fiscal year remains in the fund and shall not be credited or transferred
31 to the general fund or another fund. The department may accept gifts,
32 grants, or donations from private or public sources for the purposes of this
33 section. All private and public money received through gifts, grants, or
34 donations must be transmitted to the state treasurer, who shall credit the
35 money to the fund.

20 24-48.5-129 (4), C.R.S. To implement this act, the outdoor recreation
21 industry office may use this appropriation to execute its duties as set forth
