BILL TOPIC: CONVENIENCE FEES PROHIBITION

Summary of Legislation

The bill prohibits a seller from charging convenience fees on any sales transaction involving admission to an entertainment event. The bill does not change current law that allows state and local governments to charge convenience fees on credit or debit card transactions, as long as the fees do not exceed the cost incurred to process the payment.

Assessment

The bill impacts private transactions, and does not impact the revenue or expenditures for any state or local government agency. As a result, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 9, 2017, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 10, 2017, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
