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## **Summary of Legislation**

The bill repeals the Climate Change Markets Grant Program in the Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), which has not been operational since March 2007. The program issued grants in FY 2006-07 and recipient institutions of higher education were required to report to the CDPHE by March 15, 2007.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

The bill repeals a program that has been inactive since 2007. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on May 31, 2025, and took effect on August 6, 2025.
