HOUSE RESOLUTION 17-1006

101 **CONCERNING LEGISLATORS' REQUESTS FOR DONATIONS.**

1 *Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-first*
2 *General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

3 That in the Rules of the House of Representatives, **add** Rule No.
4 38A as follows:

5 **38A. Requests For Donations**

6 (a) DURING A SESSION OF THE HOUSE, A LEGISLATOR MAY, WITH PRIOR
7 APPROVAL OF BOTH THE MAJORITY LEADER AND THE MINORITY
8 LEADER, REQUEST OTHER LEGISLATORS TO MAKE DONATIONS TO
9 ANY TYPE OF CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION. THE FACT THAT A
10 LOBBYIST OR EMPLOYEE OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HEARS THE
11 REQUEST MADE TO OTHER LEGISLATORS IS NOT A VIOLATION OF
12 SUBSECTION (b) OF THIS RULE.

13 (b) A LEGISLATOR SHALL NOT REQUEST A LOBBYIST OR AN EMPLOYEE
14 OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO MAKE DONATIONS TO ANY TYPE OF
15 CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION.

1 (c) A LEGISLATOR SHALL NOT REQUEST AN EMPLOYEE OF THE
2 GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO MAKE A DONATION TO THE LEGISLATOR'S
3 CAMPAIGN.

4 That in the Rules of the House of Representatives, Rule No. 39,
5 **amend** (a); and **repeal** (c) and (d) as follows:

39. Lobbyists

7 (a) For the purposes of this Rule and Rules 40 and RULES 38A, 40,
8 AND 41 of the House, a lobbyist is any person defined as such in
9 the Joint Rules of the Senate and House of Representatives.

10 (c) A legislator shall not request a lobbyist or an employee of the
11 General Assembly to make donations to any type of charitable
12 organization.

13 (d) A legislator shall not request an employee of the General
14 Assembly to make a donation to the legislator's campaign.
