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1           *Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-first General Assembly*

31 \*The Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of  
 32 Representatives are authorized to hire Legislative Aides pursuant to Joint  
 33 Rule 39 of the House of Representatives and the Senate. If Legislative  
 34 Aides are authorized by the Executive Committee, acting in accordance  
 35 with such Joint Rule 39, to start prior to the convening of the next regular  
 36 session, they may be paid at the rate specified in this resolution from the  
 37 date they are authorized to start.

38 (2) That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House

1 of Representatives remain in such capacity after adjournment of the  
2 General Assembly *sine die* until the convening of the Second Regular  
3 Session of the Seventy-first General Assembly in January 2018.

4 (3) That the Chair of the Senate Services Committee, with the  
5 authorization of the President, and the Chair of the House Services  
6 Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker, are hereby separately  
7 authorized to retain and hire replacements for such employees for such  
8 period of time in the interim between the First Regular Session of the  
9 Seventy-first General Assembly and the Second Regular Session of the  
10 Seventy-First General Assembly as they deem necessary for their  
11 respective houses; except that the office equipment of the General  
12 Assembly and the services of such employees shall be used only in  
13 connection with official legislative business.

14 (4) That the Chair of the Senate Services Committee, with the  
15 authorization of the President, and the Chair of the House Services  
16 Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker, are hereby separately  
17 authorized to hire such session-only employees for the next regular session  
18 as they deem necessary for their respective houses and who may start their  
19 employment on the date authorized.

20 (5) That the officers and the employees referred to in subsections (2)  
21 through (4) of this resolution shall be compensated for their services at the  
22 rate specified for such positions during the First Regular Session of this  
23 Seventy-first General Assembly, as may be modified by any salary survey  
24 adjustments and merit increases to become effective during the fiscal year  
25 beginning July 1, 2017, which are approved by the President of the Senate  
26 for officers and employees of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of  
27 Representatives for officers and employees of the House of  
28 Representatives. All such compensation shall be paid from money  
29 appropriated for such purposes by the Seventy-first General Assembly.
