Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriations clause that provides a total of \$274,500 for FY 2025-26. The appropriation includes \$46,665 General Fund and the anticipated receipt of \$90,585 federal funds to the Department of Human Services. These amounts are reappropriated to the Office of Information Technology in the Governor's Office.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2025-26 based on the March 2025 Office of State Planning and Budgeting (OSPB) revenue forecast. The budget package includes \$18.2

million in set-asides for legislation outside of the package (see table below). The budget package accounts for the 15.0 percent reserve associated with the placeholders.

This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$46,665 for FY 2025-26, reducing the \$18.2 million set aside by the same amount.
