- 11 (d) "CO-RESPONDER COMMUNITY RESPONSE" MEANS A MODEL OF 12 CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVERSION THAT PAIRS LAW ENFORCEMENT AND 13 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROVIDERS TO INTERVENE AND RESPOND TO 14 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH-RELATED CALLS FOR POLICE SERVICE, UTILIZING THE 15 COMBINED EXPERTISE OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND 16 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SPECIALIST TO DE-ESCALATE SITUATIONS AND HELP 17 LINK INDIVIDUALS WITH BEHAVIORAL HEALTH ISSUES TO APPROPRIATE 18 SERVICES.
