"Custom Processing of Meat Animals Act" (act) by: Extending the act for 13 years; and Authorizing custom meat processors licensed under the act to sell poultry to retail food establishments. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, repeal (14)(a)(IV); and add (24)(a)(V) as follows: 24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative **declaration - repeal.** (14) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, are scheduled for repeal on July 1, 2018: (IV) The regulation by the department of agriculture of the custom processing of meat animals in accordance with article 33 of title 35, C.R.S.; (24) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, are scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2023: (V) THE REGULATION OF THE CUSTOM PROCESSING OF MEAT ANIMALS BY THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 33 OF TITLE 35. **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 35-33-407 as

35-33-407. Repeal of article. This article ARTICLE 33 is repealed, effective July 1, 2018. Prior to such September 1, 2023. Before its repeal, the licensing functions of the department shall be reviewed as provided for in ARE SCHEDULED FOR REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH section 24-34-104. C.R.S.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 35-33-301, amend
