Joint Budget Committee. Effective July 1, 2025, the bill repeals certain statutes relating to rodent pest control.

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **add** 35-7-118 as
2 follows:

3 **35-7-118. Repeal of part.** THIS PART 1 IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2025.

5 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,
6 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
7 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
8 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
9 institutions.
