#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision making the following changes to appropriations to the Department of Education for FY 2019-20: (1) an increase of \$183,722,505 General Fund for the State Share of Districts' Total Program Funding; and (2) a decrease of \$8,939,591 cash funds from the State Education Fund to eliminate the appropriation for Hold-harmless Full-day Kindergarten Funding.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2019-20 based on the March 2019 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2019-20 budget package \$185,000,000 General Fund to be appropriated for the implementation of this bill.
