### **Bill Summary**

The bill creates a public or assisted housing benefit exception to the requirement that an applicant for federal, state, or local public benefits verify lawful presence in the United States.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:						
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-76.5-103, amend						
3	(3)(h) and (3)(i); and <b>add</b> (3)(j) as follows:						
4	24-76.5-103. Verification of lawful presence - exceptions -						
5	reporting - rules. (3) Verification of lawful presence in the United						
6	States is not required:						
7	(h) For renewing an educator license pursuant to article 60.5 of						
8	title 22; <del>C.R.S.; or</del>						
9	(i) For receipt of educational services or benefits from institutions						
10	of higher education, except as may be limited pursuant to section						
11	23-7-110, including participation in the college opportunity fund program						
12	pursuant to part 2 of article 18 of title 23, college savings plans pursuant						
13	to section 23-3.1-301, state student financial assistance pursuant to article						
14	3.3 of title 23, and any other financial benefit of the institution of higher						
15	education relating to attendance at the institution of higher education; OR						
16	(j) UNLESS OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY FEDERAL LAW, FOR RECEIPT						
17	OF PUBLIC OR ASSISTED HOUSING, HOUSING SERVICES, HOUSING						
18	ASSISTANCE, OR OTHER SIMILAR BENEFIT.						
19	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,						
20	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate						
21	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.						

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
