WHEREAS, In May 2016, Colorado became the first state in the nation to establish a state holiday for our public lands when the Colorado General Assembly passed a bill establishing the third Saturday in May as "Public Lands Day"; and

WHEREAS, The bill passed with bipartisan support and was signed into law by Governor Hickenlooper, and the inaugural event was celebrated on May 20, 2017; and

WHEREAS, "Public Lands Day" is a day to celebrate our public lands as vital resources providing clean water, protecting wildlife habitats, and offering many recreation opportunities; and

WHEREAS, "Public Lands Day" is also a day to celebrate how our public lands are central to our economy and our quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Communities and businesses in Colorado that thrive around public lands fuel a bustling outdoor recreation economy that supports nearly 230,000 local jobs and contributes more than \$28 billion in consumer spending per year; and

WHEREAS, 2021 marks the fifth anniversary of the celebration of "Public Lands Day"; now, therefore,

*Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-third General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring herein:*




