

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado;

SECTION 1. IN COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, **ADD** PART 52 TO ARTICLE 22 TO TITLE 39 AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 22

39-22-5201. SHORT TITLE

(1) THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS THE "TAX CREDIT FOR VOTING ACT".

39-22-5202. DEFINITIONS

(1) VOTERS: COLORADO REGISTERED VOTERS THAT VOTED IN THE PRIMARY AND/OR GENERAL ELECTIONS FOR GOVERNOR AND STATE OR FEDERAL CONGRESSIONAL SEATS

39-22-5203. CREDIT AGAINST TAX – VOTING PARTICIPATION

(1) A REFUNDABLE STATE TAX CREDIT WILL BE ISSUED TO VOTERS OF THE STATE OF COLORADO

(2) PARTICIPANTS THAT VOTED IN THE PRIMARY ELECTIONS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A FORTY DOLLAR TAX CREDIT

(3) PARTICIPANTS THAT VOTED IN THE GENERAL ELECTIONS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A FORTY DOLLAR TAX CREDIT

(4) VOTERS WILL HAVE TO VOLUNTARILY CLAIM THEIR TAX CREDIT ON THE COLORADO STATE TAX FORMS
