Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado;

SECTION 1. IN COLORADO REVISED STATUTES, **ADD** PART 52 TO ARTICLE 22 TO TITLE 39 AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 22

- 39-22-5201. SHORT TITLE
 - (1) This article shall be known and may be cited as the "Tax Credit for Voting Act".

39-22-5202. DEFINITIONS

- (1) VOTERS: COLORADO REGISTERED VOTERS THAT VOTED IN THE PRIMARY AND/OR GENERAL ELECTIONS FOR GOVERNOR AND STATE OR FEDERAL CONGRESSIONAL SEATS
- 39-22-5203. CREDIT AGAINST TAX VOTING PARTICIPATION
 - (1) A REFUNDABLE STATE TAX CREDIT WILL BE ISSUED TO VOTERS OF THE STATE OF COLORADO
 - (2) PARTICIPANTS THAT VOTED IN THE PRIMARY ELECTIONS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A FORTY DOLLAR TAX CREDIT
 - (3) PARTICIPANTS THAT VOTED IN THE GENERAL ELECTIONS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A FORTY DOLLAR TAX CREDIT
 - (4) VOTERS WILL HAVE TO VOLUNTARILY CLAIM THEIR TAX CREDIT ON THE COLORADO STATE TAX FORMS
