(1) (f) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY 5 PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE TO THE CONTRARY, A WHOLESALER LICENSED 6 PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (1) MAY ESTABLISH A 7 PROGRAM FOR ITS EMPLOYEES TO PURCHASE DIRECTLY FROM THE 8 WHOLESALER VINOUS OR SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS SOLD BY THAT 9 WHOLESALER. 10 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 11 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 12 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
