# **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$40,000,000 from the Colorado Economic Development Fund, originally from federal money received from the Federal Coronavirus State Recovery Fund, to the Office of the Governor for use by the Office of Economic Development and International Trade for COVID-19 affected business assistance in FY 2021-22. It also provides \$21,958 from the Economic Recovery and Relief Cash Fund to the Legislative Department for costs to administer the task force.

# **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**L.002** Bill Sponsor amendment **L.002** (attached) adds some additional language to statute to expand allowed uses of the Economic Recovery and Relief Cash Fund to assistance for individuals and households, assistance to nonprofit organizations, public health expenditures for COVID-19 prevention and response, and administrative costs. It also provides a mechanism that allows the State Controller to separately track funds that originate as General Fund from those that originate as federal funds.

### **Points to Consider**

### General Fund Impact

Adopting amendment L.002 provides for an appropriation of \$21,958 from the Economic Recovery and Relief Cash Fund from money that originates from the General Fund; however, this bill does not currently include any transfers from the General Fund into the cash fund.
