A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING EXPANDED ELIGIBILITY FOR A VETERAN OF THE 102 VIETNAM WAR SPECIALTY LICENSE PLATE.

Bill Summary

The bill extends the end date to be eligible for a veteran of the Vietnam war specialty license plate from January 27, 1973, to January 27, 1975.

1	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-213, amend
2	(11)(b) and (11)(c) as follows:
3	42-3-213. License plates - military veterans - rules -
4	retirement. (11) Veteran of the Vietnam war. (b) A natural person
5	may use a veteran of the Vietnam war special license plate if such THE
6	person was a member of the United States armed services between
7	August 7, 1964, and <u>January 27, 1973 MAY 7, 1975.</u>
8	(c) The department or an authorized agent shall not issue a veteran
9	of the Vietnam war special license plate to an applicant until the applicant
10	provides a DD214 form issued by the United States government or other
11	evidence sufficient to demonstrate that the applicant is a veteran of the
12	armed services who served between August 7, 1964, and <u>January 27</u> ,
13	<u>1973 May 7, 1975.</u>
14	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
15	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
16	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
17	8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a
18	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
19	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
20	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
21	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
22	November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
23	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
