2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1614,

3       **amend** (4) (a) as follows:

4           **24-33.5-1614. Homeland security and all-hazards senior**  
5       **advisory committee - composition - duties - emergency planning**  
6       **subcommittee - public safety communications subcommittee -**  
7       **creation - definitions.** (4) (a) This section is repealed effective  
8       September 1, 2021. SEPTEMBER 1, 2031.

10          **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **add** (21);  
11       **and repeal** (12)(a)(I) as follows:

12          **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative**  
13       **declaration - definition - repeal.** (12) (a) The following statutory  
14       authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on  
15       September 1, 2021:

16           (I) The homeland security and all-hazards senior advisory  
17       committee created in section 24-33.5-1614, C.R.S.;

18           (21) (a) THE FOLLOWING STATUTORY AUTHORIZATIONS FOR THE  
19       DESIGNATED ADVISORY COMMITTEES WILL REPEAL ON SEPTEMBER 1,  
20       2031:

21           (I) THE HOMELAND SECURITY AND ALL-HAZARDS SENIOR  
22       ADVISORY COMMITTEE CREATED IN SECTION 24-33.5-1614.

23           (b) THIS SUBSECTION (21) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1,  
24       2033.

25          **SECTION 3. Effective date.** This act takes effect September 1,

2 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
3 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
4 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
