#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill:**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that decreases the appropriation from the Public School Capital Construction Assistance Fund to the Department of Education by \$20,000,000 in FY 2024-25.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**L.001** Bill sponsor amendment **L.001** (attached) changes the transfer date in the bill from July 1, 2026 to June 1, 2026 to reflect the JBC's intent to postpone the transfer by two fiscal years. The introduced version of the bill postpones the transfer by three fiscal years.

#### **Points to Consider**

## Marijuana Tax Cash Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2024-25 based on the March 2024 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. As part of balancing for the Marijuana Tax Cash Fund, the JBC has included as part of its FY 2024-25 budget package the \$20.0 million reduction to the transfer from the fund that would result from the passage of this bill.

#### Related Budget Information

The introduced FY 2024-25 Long Bill includes an appropriation of \$175,245,826 cash funds for Public School Capital Construction Assistance Board Cash Grants. This bill reduces the FY 2024-25 appropriation to \$155,245,826. For comparision, the program received appropriations of \$110,000,000 in FY 2022-23 and and \$159,705,220 in FY 2023-24.
