Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In the Constitution of the State of Colorado, at article X, **add** section 22 as follows:

Section 22. Local control of property tax revenues.

Any voter initiative or voter referendum that, by adjustment of the assessment rate or mill levy, affects the property tax revenues of a local government shall be decided only in a local election by individuals entitled to vote in that election. Local government, as used in this section, shall mean any city, county, school district, special district, or any other district that relies on property taxes for all or a portion of its revenues.
