Bill Summary

Current law prohibits an employee of a tavern or lodging and entertainment facility who is under 21 years of age from selling malt, vinous, or spirituous liquors.

The bill permits a licensed tavern or lodging and entertainment facility that regularly serves meals to allow an employee who is at least 18 years of age but under 21 years of age to sell malt, vinous, or spirituous liquors if the employee is supervised on-site by a person who is at least 21 years of age.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-47-901, amend 3 (5) introductory portion and (5)(p)(II) as follows: 4 12-47-901. Unlawful acts - exceptions - definitions. (5) It is 5 unlawful for any person licensed to sell at retail pursuant to this article 6 ARTICLE 47 or article 46 of this title TITLE 12: 7 (p) (II) If licensed as a tavern under section 12-47-412 THAT DOES 8 NOT REGULARLY SERVE MEALS, a lodging and entertainment facility under 9 section 12-47-426 THAT DOES NOT REGULARLY SERVE MEALS, a retail 10 liquor store under section 12-47-407, or a liquor-licensed drugstore under 11 section 12-47-408, to permit an employee who is under twenty-one years 12 of age to sell malt, vinous, or spirituous liquors; or 13 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 14 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 15 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
