1 *Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-first General Assembly*
2 *of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring herein:*

37 (2) That the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the
38 House of Representatives remain in such capacity after adjournment of

1 the General Assembly *sine die* until the convening of the First Regular
2 Session of the Seventy-second General Assembly in January 2019.

3 (3) That the Chair of the Senate Services Committee, with the
4 authorization of the President, and the Chair of the House Services
5 Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker, are hereby separately
6 authorized to retain and hire replacements for such employees for such
7 period of time in the interim between the Second Regular Session of the
8 Seventy-first General Assembly and the First Regular Session of the
9 Seventy-second General Assembly as they deem necessary for their
10 respective houses; except that the office equipment of the General
11 Assembly and the services of such employees shall be used only in
12 connection with official legislative business.

13 (4) That the Chair of the Senate Services Committee, with the
14 authorization of the President, and the Chair of the House Services
15 Committee, with the authorization of the Speaker, are hereby separately
16 authorized to hire such session-only employees for the next regular
17 session as they deem necessary for their respective houses and who may
18 start their employment on the date authorized.

19 (5) That the officers and the employees referred to in subsections
20 (2) through (4) of this resolution shall be compensated for their services
21 at the rate specified for such positions during the Second Regular Session
22 of this Seventy-first General Assembly, as may be modified by any salary
23 survey adjustments and merit increases to become effective during the
24 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, which are approved by the President
25 of the Senate for officers and employees of the Senate and the Speaker of
26 the House of Representatives for officers and employees of the House of
27 Representatives. All such compensation shall be paid from money
28 appropriated for such purposes by the Seventy-first General Assembly.
