Bill Summary

The bill adds autism spectrum disorders and acute pain to the list of disabling medical conditions that authorize a person to use medical marijuana for his or her condition.

16	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1.5-106.5, amend
17	(3)(b)(I) as follows:
18	25-1.5-106.5. Medical marijuana health research grant
19	program. (3) (b) Grant approval. (I) The council shall submit
20	recommendations for grants to the state board of health. The state board
21	of health shall approve or disapprove of grants submitted by the council.
22	THE STATE BOARD IS ENCOURAGED TO PRIORITIZE GRANTS TO GATHER
23	OBJECTIVE SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH REGARDING THE EFFICACY AND THE
24	SAFETY OF ADMINISTERING MEDICAL MARIJUANA FOR PEDIATRIC
25	CONDITIONS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO AUTISM SPECTRUM
