## A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE ANNUAL IN-SERVICE TRAINING REQUIRED FOR A COUNTY SHERIFF.

### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at <a href="http://leg.colorado.gov">http://leg.colorado.gov</a>.)

Each person elected or appointed to the office of sheriff is required, with certain exceptions, to undergo at least 20 hours of in-service training each year during the sheriff's term. The bill modifies this provision to require each sheriff to undergo at least the number of hours required for all certified peace officers by the peace officers standards and training board (POST board). Current law further requires

the training to be provided by the county sheriffs of Colorado, incorporated. The bill allows the training to also be provided by any other training resource agency approved by the POST board.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:* 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 30-10-501.6, amend 3 (2) as follows: 4 **30-10-501.6.** Training. (2) Every sheriff must possess basic 5 peace officer certification and shall undergo at least twenty THE NUMBER 6 OF clock hours of in-service training REQUIRED FOR ALL CERTIFIED PEACE 7 OFFICERS BY THE COLORADO PEACE OFFICERS STANDARDS AND TRAINING 8 BOARD. SUCH TRAINING SHALL BE provided EITHER by the county sheriffs 9 of Colorado, incorporated, OR ANY OTHER TRAINING RESOURCE AGENCY 10 APPROVED BY THE COLORADO PEACE OFFICERS STANDARDS AND TRAINING 11 BOARD, every year during such sheriff's term. The Colorado peace 12 officers standards and training board shall have discretion to waive 13 in-service training upon presentation of evidence by the sheriff 14 demonstrating just cause for noncompletion of such training. The 15 Colorado peace officers standards and training board shall have discretion 16 to allow the substitution of any combination of education, experience, and 17 training deemed by the board to be equivalent to such in-service training 18 of at least twenty clock hours annually. 19 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -20 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following 21 the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the 22 general assembly (August 9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 23 2017); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 24 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,

- or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
- 5 (2) This act applies to years of a sheriff's term that commence on or after January 1, 2018.
