Bill Topic:	WOMEN VETERANS APPRECIATION DAY
Summary of Fiscal Impact:	<b>No fiscal impact.</b> The bill establishes Women Veterans Appreciation Day. The bill does not impact state and local expenditures and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
Appropriation Summary:	No appropriation required.
Fiscal Note Status:	The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill establishes June 12 as "Women Veterans Appreciation Day," an observed state holiday.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

Observed holidays, unlike legal holidays, do not impact hours worked for state employees. The observed holiday may shift the school year calendar for any school district that chooses to give students the day off. Such observed holidays do not impact state revenues or expenditures, and thus this additional observed holiday is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
