A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF "TELEMEDICINE" FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE "COLORADO MEDICAL PRACTICE ACT".

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov.)

For the purposes of the "Colorado Medical Practice Act", the bill amends the definition of "telemedicine" to state that the term means the delivery of medical services through HIPAA-compliant telecommunications systems, including information, electronic, and communication technologies, remote monitoring technologies, and store-and-forward transfers, to facilitate the assessment, diagnosis,

consultation, or treatment of a patient while the patient is located at an originating site and the physician, anesthesiologist assistant, or physician assistant is located at a distant site.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-240-104, amend 3 (6); and **add** (5.7), (5.8), and (5.9) as follows: 4 12-240-104. **Definitions.** As used in this article 240, unless the 5 context otherwise requires: 6 (5.7) "DISTANT SITE" HAS THE MEANING SET FORTH IN SECTION 7 10-16-123 (4)(a). (5.8) "Originating site" has the meaning set forth in 8 9 SECTION 10-16-123 (4)(b). 10 (5.9) "STORE-AND-FORWARD TRANSFER" HAS THE MEANING SET 11 FORTH IN SECTION 10-16-123 (4)(c). 12 (6) "Telemedicine" means the delivery of medical services and 13 any THROUGH TECHNOLOGIES THAT ARE USED IN A MANNER THAT IS 14 COMPLIANT WITH THE FEDERAL "HEALTH INSURANCE PORTABILITY AND 15 ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 1996", PUB.L. 104-91, AS AMENDED, INCLUDING 16 INFORMATION, ELECTRONIC, AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGIES, 17 REMOTE MONITORING TECHNOLOGIES, AND STORE-AND-FORWARD 18 TRANSFERS, TO FACILITATE THE ASSESSMENT, diagnosis, consultation, or 19 treatment using interactive audio, interactive video, or interactive data 20 communication OF A PATIENT WHILE THE PATIENT IS LOCATED AT AN 21 ORIGINATING SITE AND THE PERSON WHO PROVIDES THE SERVICES IS 22 LOCATED AT A DISTANT SITE. 23 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-240-107, amend 24 (1)(g) as follows:
