Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause to add a provision appropriating \$25,000 General Fund to the Youth Advisory Council Cash Fund for FY 2018-19. Please note that this cash fund is continuously appropriated in Section 2-2-1306, C.R.S., so an appropriation out of this cash fund to the Legislative Department is not necessary.

Points to Consider*General Fund Impact*

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package leaves approximately \$40.8 million General Fund unallocated. Thus, the General Assembly could appropriate up to \$38.3 million General Fund to fund 2018 legislation and maintain a 6.5 percent General Fund reserve. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$25,000 for FY 2018-19, reducing the excess General Fund reserve by \$26,625.
