After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB24-1025 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on <u>Appropriations</u> with favorable recommendation:

- Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and substitute:
 - "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-16-155, add (3)(d) as follows:
 - 10-16-155. Actuarial reviews of proposed health-care legislation division to contract with third parties required considerations confidentiality limits on expenditures repeal. (3) (d) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary, the legislative proposals that the contractors shall review pursuant to subsection (1) of this section, for purposes of proposed legislation considered during the 2025 legislative session, must include coverage by individual and small group health benefit plans for the diagnosis of and treatment for infertility and standard fertility preservation services, as those terms are defined in section 10-16-104 (23)(g)(IV) and (23)(g)(VIII).

SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."

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
