After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB24-1025 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, strike everything below the enacting clause and
2 substitute:

3 "SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-16-155, add
4 (3)(d) as follows:

5 **10-16-155. Actuarial reviews of proposed health-care**
6 **legislation - division to contract with third parties - required**
7 **considerations - confidentiality - limits on expenditures - repeal.**

8 (3) (d) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION TO THE
9 CONTRARY, THE LEGISLATIVE PROPOSALS THAT THE CONTRACTORS SHALL
10 REVIEW PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1) OF THIS SECTION, FOR PURPOSES OF
11 PROPOSED LEGISLATION CONSIDERED DURING THE 2025 LEGISLATIVE
12 SESSION, MUST INCLUDE COVERAGE BY INDIVIDUAL AND SMALL GROUP
13 HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS FOR THE DIAGNOSIS OF AND TREATMENT FOR
14 INFERTILITY AND STANDARD FERTILITY PRESERVATION SERVICES, AS
15 THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN SECTION 10-16-104 (23)(g)(IV) AND
16 (23)(g)(VIII).

17 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
18 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
19 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
20 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
21 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
22 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
23 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
24 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
25 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor."

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
