BILL TOPIC: INFORM STUDENTS & PARENTS OF EDUCATION LEADING TO JOBS

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, charter schools authorized by the State Charter School Institute (institute charter schools) are required to assist parents and students to create an Individual Career and Academic Plan (ICAP). This **reengrossed** bill requires that institute charter schools also discuss the benefits of military enlistment when discussing ICAPs.

Under current law, all public schools are required to provide parents and students information about ICAPs and options for concurrent enrollment. When having these discussions, schools are required to discuss educational opportunities available via military enlistment. In discussing military enlistment with a student and his or her parent, the bill encourages but does not require that public schools provide certain information concerning the military enlistment test, including suggestions on how to prepare for the test.

School District Impact

The bill minimally increases the workload of school districts and institute charter schools to provide information to students concerning the benefits of military enlistment, and if they choose to, information concerning the military enlistment test.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 9, 2017, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 10, 2017, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
