SEC. 1320d TO 5 1320d-9, AND ITS RELATED PRIVACY AND SECURITY REGULATIONS, ARE 6 AUTHORIZED TO DIRECTLY CONNECT TO THE PROGRAM THROUGH 7 RXCHECK. IN ORDER TO COMPLETE THE REQUIRED RXCHECK 8 ENABLEMENT, THE DIVISION MAY AUTHORIZE PUBLIC OR PRIVATE 9 INTEGRATION ORGANIZATIONS TO PROVIDE TO THE DIVISION REASONABLE 10 AND NECESSARY PROGRAM OUERY AUDIT REPORTS SHOULD AUDIT 11 REPORTING FUNCTIONALITY NOT BE SUFFICIENT FOR THE DIVISION 12 THROUGH RXCHECK. NOTWITHSTANDING THE ENABLEMENT OF RXCHECK 13 DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION (6), THE PROGRAM, WHETHER DEVELOPED 14 BY THE BOARD OR PROCURED, MUST ALLOW DIRECT APPLICATION 15 PROGRAM INTERFACE CONNECTIONS TO THE PROGRAM THROUGH PUBLIC 16 AND PRIVATE INTEGRATION ORGANIZATIONS THAT COMPLY WITH THE 17 BUSINESS ASSOCIATE REQUIREMENTS OF THE "HEALTH INSURANCE 18 PORTABILITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 1996", AS AMENDED, 42 19 U.S.C. SEC. 1320d TO 1320d-9, AND ITS RELATED PRIVACY AND SECURITY 20 REGULATIONS. PRACTITIONERS AND HEALTH SYSTEMS, AND THE 21 INTEGRATION ORGANIZATIONS ACTING ON THEIR BEHALF, SHALL NOT BE 22 ASSESSED ANY FEES FOR THE INTEGRATION ACCESS TO THE PROGRAM 23 DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION (6), EITHER THROUGH RXCHECK OR 24 THROUGH AN APPLICATION PROGRAM INTERFACE CONNECTION.".
