1                   **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-4-2208, **repeal** (4)

2                   as follows:

3                   **25-4-2208. Necessary document program - definition.** (4) This  
4                   section is ~~repealed~~, effective September 1, 2021.

5                   **SECTION 2. Appropriation.** For the 2021-22 state fiscal year,  
6                   \$250,000 is appropriated to the department of public health and  
7                   environment for use by the office of health equity. This appropriation is  
8                   from the general fund. To implement this act, the office may use this  
9                   appropriation for necessary document assistance.

10                   **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
11                   determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
12                   preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
