BILL TOPIC: MEDICAL MARIJUANA TESTING FACILITY LOCAL LICENSING

#### **Summary of Legislation**

This bill allows a local medical marijuana licensing authority to issue medical marijuana testing facility licenses.

#### **Background**

Senate Bill15-260 authorized the creation of a state medical marijuana testing facility license and required that medical marijuana and medical marijuana-infused products be tested. The Marijuana Enforcement Division in the Department of Revenue is not scheduled to begin accepting licenses for medical marijuana testing facilities until FY 2016-17, so no such facilities are licensed at this time.

#### **Local Government Impact**

This bill will increase revenue and expenditures for local medical marijuana licensing authorities that choose to license medical marijuana testing facilities located in their jurisdictions. The fiscal note assumes that fees charged for the licenses will cover the costs of the regulation.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect upon signature of the Governor, or upon becoming law without his signature.
