that is:

- (I) (A) Designed to travel on wheels or tracks in contact with the ground; OR
- (B) USED TO TRAVEL OVER WATER USING AN INBOARD MOTOR POWERING A WATER JET PUMP OR AN OUTBOARD MOTOR-DRIVEN PROPELLER.
- (b) (I) Except as described in subsection (11.5)(b)(II) of this section, "off-highway vehicle" includes vehicles commonly known as all-terrain vehicles, snowmobiles, PERSONAL WATERCRAFT, and surplus military vehicles but does not include:
- (B) Vehicles, OTHER THAN PERSONAL WATERCRAFT, designed and used primarily for travel on, over, or in the water;
- (13.5) "PERSONAL WATERCRAFT" MEANS A MOTORBOAT THAT IS DESIGNED TO BE OPERATED BY A PERSON SITTING, STANDING, OR KNEELING ON THE VESSEL, RATHER THAN THE CONVENTIONAL MANNER OF SITTING OR STANDING INSIDE THE VESSEL, THAT IS DESIGNED PRIMARILY FOR USE OFF OF THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS, AND THAT USES EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING AS THE PRIMARY SOURCE OF MOTIVE POWER:
- (a) AN INBOARD MOTOR POWERING A WATER JET PUMP; OR
- 20 (b) AN OUTBOARD MOTOR-DRIVEN PROPELLER.".

 - "SECTION 6. Act subject to petition effective date applicability. (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the
