A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING PEACE OFFICER STATUS FOR THE ADMINISTRATOR OF 102 JUDICIAL SECURITY IN THE COLORADO JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT.

Bill Summary

The bill designates an administrator of judicial security in the Colorado judicial department as a peace officer who must be certified by the peace officer standards and training board.

1	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 16-2.5-152 as

3	16-2.5-152. Administrator of judicial security. AN
4	ADMINISTRATOR OF JUDICIAL SECURITY EMPLOYED BY THE JUDICIAL
5	DEPARTMENT IS A PEACE OFFICER WHOSE AUTHORITY INCLUDES THE
6	ENFORCEMENT OF ALL LAWS OF THE STATE OF COLORADO, AND SUCH
7	ADMINISTRATOR OF JUDICIAL SECURITY MUST BE CERTIFIED BY THE
8	P.O.S.T. BOARD.
9	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
