Resolution Summary

Beginning with the third quarter of the 2020-21 state fiscal year, the concurrent resolution allows the transfer of available net proceeds

minus any money required to pay bonds issued by law by the Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO) trust fund board of every state-supervised lottery game operated under the authority of section 2 of article XVIII of the state constitution to the state education fund.

4	SECTION 1. At the election held on November 3, 2020, the
5	secretary of state shall submit to the registered electors of the state the
6	ballot title set forth in section 2 for the following amendment to the state
7	constitution:
8	In the constitution of the state of Colorado, section 3 of article
9	XXVII, add (3) as follows:
10	Section 3. Money allocated to Trust Fund. (3) BEGINNING WITH
11	THE NET PROCEEDS MINUS ANY MONEY REQUIRED TO PAY BONDS ISSUED
12	BY LAW BY THE TRUST FUND BOARD FROM THE THIRD QUARTER OF THE
13	2020-21 STATE FISCAL YEAR, NOTWITHSTANDING THIS ARTICLE XXVII OR
14	ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, AVAILABLE NET PROCEEDS MAY BE
15	TRANSFERRED BY LAW TO THE STATE EDUCATION FUND CREATED IN
16	SECTION 17 (4) OF ARTICLE IX OF THIS CONSTITUTION.
17	SECTION 2. Each elector voting at the election may cast a vote
18	either "Yes/For" or "No/Against" on the following ballot title: "Shall
19	there be an amendment to the Colorado constitution concerning the ability
20	of the general assembly to transfer great outdoors Colorado funds by law
21	to the state education fund?"
22	SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided in section 1-40-123,
23	Colorado Revised Statutes, if at least fifty-five percent of the electors
