The 15 continuing rate of contribution shall be determined by the board utilizing certified actuarial reports prepared by the actuary for the plan. Any 16 actuarial report shall also certify, in accordance with accepted actuarial 17 18 principals, that the employers' coverage shall not have an adverse 19 financial impact on the actuarial soundness of the plan. Continuing 20 contributions for each member who is active on the effective date of 21 coverage shall be made at the rate established on said date until the 22 member's retirement or termination; except that the board may lower the 23 continuing rate of contribution in the event it finds that the original 24 continuing rate of contribution is in excess of what is required to pay the 25 cost of benefits based on the advice of the actuary. The board may 26 periodically adjust the rate prior to the election of coverage by an 27 employer based on certified actuarial reports prepared by the actuary for 28 the plan.".
