#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A TRANSFER OF MONEY FROM THE STATE EMPLOYEE
102 RESERVE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.

## **Bill Summary**

**Joint Budget Committee.** The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer \$10 million from the state employee reserve fund (fund) to the general fund on July 1, 2019. Specifically, the transfer is of money that is in the account dedicated to the department of corrections within the fund.

6	philosophy. (j) (III) (C) On July 1, 2019, the state treasurer shall
7	TRANSFER TEN MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE ACCOUNT DEDICATED TO THE
8	DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS WITHIN THE FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND
9	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
