A BILL FOR AN ACT
CONCERNING REESTABLISHMENT OF THE VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION
DESIGNATION BENEFITING THE ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATION
FUND THAT APPEARS ON THE STATE INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX
RETURN FORMS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The voluntary contribution program, commonly referred to as the tax check-off program, benefiting the Alzheimer's Association of Colorado fund (fund), was removed from the income tax return form for

failing to receive the requisite minimum contribution amount within the statutorily designated time period. The bill reestablishes the fund and provides that the fund must be placed in the tax check-off queue if necessary due to the number of funds appearing on the form at the time of reestablishment.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 **SECTION 1.** Legislative declaration - intent. (1) The general 3 assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that: 4 (a) There are currently more than sixty-five thousand persons in 5 Colorado with Alzheimer's disease, and the number of cases in Colorado 6 is expected to grow to ninety-two thousand cases by the year 2025; 7 (b) In order to provide compassionate quality care for persons 8 with Alzheimer's disease, individuals and families may require critical 9 resources and assistance available through the Alzheimer's Association 10 of Colorado: 11 (c) Alzheimer's disease, otherwise known as "the long goodbye", 12 creates a tremendous emotional and financial burden on the family and 13 friends of those with the disease; 14 (d) Approximately seventy percent of persons with Alzheimer's 15 disease live at home and approximately forty percent of caregivers report 16 high levels of emotional and financial stress, which can have a negative 17 impact on the caregiver's performance at work and in other areas of life; 18 Approximately two hundred sixty-six thousand unpaid caregivers provide care worth over three million dollars; 19 20 The Alzheimer's Association provides vital support for 21 individuals and families in caring for persons with the disease by making 22 available a twenty-four hour help line, educational classes, support 23 groups, caregiver respite, resources, and family counseling services in

1	urban and rural communities throughout Colorado;
2	(g) The Alzheimer's Association may not have sufficient resources
3	to cope with the growing demand for services that individuals and
4	families need; and
5	(h) Many Colorado citizens choose to contribute funds to the
6	Alzheimer's Association to allay the devastation of the disease and ease
7	the burden of care on Colorado families, communities, and businesses.
8	(2) Therefore, it is the intent of the general assembly to continue
9	to provide Colorado citizens the opportunity to financially support the
10	statewide programs of the Alzheimer's Association by allowing citizens
11	to make voluntary contributions on their state income tax return forms for
12	that purpose.
13	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 39-22-2901
14	as follows:
15	39-22-2901. Voluntary contribution designation - procedure.
16	(1) For the five income tax years that commence on or after January 1,
17	2011, but before January 1, 2016 IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE YEAR IN
18	WHICH THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FILES WRITTEN CERTIFICATION WITH THE
19	REVISOR OF STATUTES AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 39-22-1001 (8) THAT A
20	LINE ON THE INCOME TAX RETURN FORM IS AVAILABLE AND THE
21	ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATION FUND VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION IS ENTITLED
22	TO THAT LINE, EITHER BECAUSE THE BILL REESTABLISHING THE
23	ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATION FUND VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION WAS
24	SIGNED BY THE GOVERNOR OR BECAME LAW WITHOUT THE GOVERNOR'S
25	SIGNATURE PRIOR TO ANY OTHER BILL CREATING OR REESTABLISHING ANY
26	OTHER VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION OR BECAUSE IT IS NEXT IN THE QUEUE
27	ESTABLISHED DUDGUANT TO SAID SECTION 39-22-1001 (8) THE EVECUTIVE

1	DIRECTOR SHALL ENSURE THAT the Colorado state individual income tax

9	BILL 16, ENACTED IN 2016, MUST BE TREATED AS THOUGH IT IS
10	CREATING THAT VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION "FOR THE FIRST TIME" FOR
11	PURPOSES OF PLACING AND ORDERING THAT VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION
12	IN THE QUEUE CREATED IN SECTION 39-22-1001 (8).
13	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 39-22-2903
14	as follows:
15	39-22-2903. Repeal of part. This part 29 is repealed, effective
16	January 1 2017 of the Sixth income tax year following the year in
17	WHICH THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FILES WRITTEN CERTIFICATION WITH THE
18	REVISOR OF STATUTES AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 39-22-1001 (8) THAT A
19	LINE HAS BECOME AVAILABLE AND THE ALZHEIMER'S ASSOCIATION FUND
20	VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION IS ENTITLED TO THAT LINE, unless the
21	voluntary contribution to the Alzheimer's Association fund established by
22	section 39-22-2902 is continued or reestablished by the general assembly
23	acting by bill prior to said THAT date.
24	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
25	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
26	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
