## Fiscal Summary of Initiative 109

This fiscal summary, prepared by the nonpartisan Director of Research of the Legislative Council, contains a preliminary assessment of the measure's fiscal impact. A full fiscal impact statement for this initiative is or will be available at [leg.colorado.gov/bluebook](http://leg.colorado.gov/bluebook). This fiscal summary identifies the following impact.

### State Expenditures

Workload and legal costs in the Colorado Department of Education may increase if school districts are intentionally out of compliance with the measure and the Commissioner of Education is required to take remedial action. Legal services are provided by the Department of Law. State institutions of higher education will also have additional expenditures to adopt or update policies for all interscholastic or intramural athletic programs.

### Local Government

The measure may increase expenditures for schools, school districts and charter schools that offer interscholastic or intramural athletic programs to update policies. These costs are expected to be minimal. To the extent the Colorado Department of Education takes remedial action against school districts, costs may also increase.

### Economic Impacts

The measure is not expected to have a direct impact on the state's economy.
