A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING A DUTY OF THE DIVISION OF FIRE PREVENTION AND CONTROL TO CONDUCT WILDLAND FIRE INVESTIGATIONS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill establishes that conducting investigations of wildland fires in the state is a duty of the division of fire prevention and control within the department of public safety and makes an appropriation to fund such investigations.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1203, add
3	(1)(x) as follows:
4	24-33.5-1203. Duties of division. (1) The division shall perform
5	the following duties:
6	(x) CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS INTO THE CAUSES OF WILDLAND
7	FIRES THAT OCCUR WITHIN THE STATE AND, AT A MINIMUM, CONDUCTING
8	INVESTIGATIONS FOR NINETY PERCENT OF WILDLAND FIRES THAT OCCUR
9	IN THE STATE OVER A THREE-YEAR ROLLING AVERAGE.
10	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1203.5,
11	amend (3) as follows:
12	24-33.5-1203.5. Powers and duties of director - report.
13	(3) Commencing in 2014, the director shall report annually to the
14	wildfire matters review committee created in section 2-3-1602 C.R.S.,
15	regarding the current nature and magnitude of the state's wildfire
16	WILDLAND FIRE situation, THE NUMBER OF WILDLAND FIRE
17	INVESTIGATIONS THE DIVISION CONDUCTED IN THE PRECEDING CALENDAR
18	YEAR, AND THE STATUS OF OR, IF THE INVESTIGATION IS COMPLETED, THE
19	RESULTS OF, EACH INVESTIGATION, the status of wildfire WILDLAND FIRE
20	preparedness and prescribed burns in the state, including available
21	resources, and the challenges to addressing the state's wildfire WILDLAND
22	FIRE threat. The report required by this subsection (3) is exempt from the
23	automatic expiration described in section 24-1-136 (11).
24	SECTION 3. Appropriation. For the 2022-23 state fiscal year,
25	\$204,649 is appropriated to the department of public safety for use by the
26	division of fire prevention and control for investigations of the causes of

wildland fires that occur within the state. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this section, the division may use this appropriation for conducting wildland fire investigations as set forth in section 24-33.5-1203(1)(x), C.R.S.

SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
