### Future Fiscal Impact

Although this bill does not require an appropriation for FY 2025-26, it is projected to require a total appropriation of \$70,354, including \$55,638 General Fund, in FY 2026-27. This decreases to a total appropriation of \$40,801 in FY 2027-28, comprised entirely of General Fund.
