- WHEREAS, Children have a right to thrive, learn, and grow to their full potential; and
- WHEREAS, The prevention of child abuse and neglect strengthens
 Colorado's families and communities and ensures the opportunity for
 children to develop in healthy, trusting families, schools, and
 neighborhoods that build the foundation of society; and
 - WHEREAS, We all play a role in preventing child abuse and neglect, and there are ways everyone can get involved to help a child, even those individuals who aren't raising a child or working with children every day; just one person has the power to make an extraordinary difference in the lives of both children and families; and
